"Did she cool down yet?"

"Where should we go next on vacation?"

/WAIR - shud - weee - goh - nehkst - ahn - vay - KAY - shuhn/

"When is our flight?"

/WEH - nih - zahr - FLIT/

"Why are we practicing at 9am?"

/WI - (y) - ahr - weee - PRAEK - tuh - sing - a? - NI - nay - (y) - ehm/

"How does she wake up that early?"

/HOW - duhz - sheee - way - KUHP - thae - DER - leee/

"What did you notice out there today?"

/WUH? - dihd - yuuu - NOH - dih - sow? - thair - tuh - DAY/
